

Samaca Q53 Slate



Samaca Q53 is a dark blue grey slate produced in the Los Molinos region of Northern Spain. The slate has a good natural texture giving the appearance of a domestically quarried slate to the finished roof. The duller texture of the slate is in contrast to many imported slates which can have a very noticeable sheen on the roof.

With over 40 years experience in producing quality roofing slate for the global market, slate from one of Samaca's 11 quarries in Spain is the obvious choice for a trouble free, totally traceable from quarry face to roof, fully tested slate.

The slate is available in two thickness selections, 7mm nominal and 5mm nominal, thus giving the architect, developer or contractor a choice which will suit the desired overall aesthetics of the project.

The quarry also produce a slightly thicker "Scotia" grade in smaller sizes which is becoming very popular in Scotland. This option is a more rugged quality selection which mimics the look of traditional Scottish slates which are sadly no longer available.

All thickness options are regularly fully tested to the current European Standard BSEN12326-1:2004 and attain the highest certification of A1, T1 And S1.
